ENGLISH MARTYRS- This week Martyr is Robert Salt. Robert Salt was one of the many Carthusian monks at the Charterhouse monastery in London who were persecuted for their Catholic faith. He refused to swear the Oath of Supremacy, which would have required him to deny his Catholic faith and the authority of the Pope and instead to acknowledge Henry V111 as the supreme church leader. His refusal led him to be imprisoned at Newgate Jail where he was starved to death. His courage in circumstances where he knew death was the consequence is an inspiration in times where we may face challenge or strife, to remember that our faith in God will provide us with strength to face adversity.
