BAPTISM AT ENGLISH MARTYRS CHURCH: Baptism is a Sacrament of faith, and the Church asks for a serious and loving commitment by the parents and godparents of a child to live the life of the Sacraments. ENGLISH MARTYRS- This week Martyr is Thomas Welbourne. Thomas was a Catholic school teacher in Yorkshire. He was very public in his faith and his encouragement to others to keep their Catholic faith despite this having been made illegal in England by King Henry V111. As a teacher he would have been prominent in his community and as a result he was arrested and executed at York on 1 August 1605. We can all remember teachers who have inspired us and encouraged us to be brave or bold, just as Thomas did for those he encountered.
