BAPTISM AT ENGLISH MARTYRS CHURCH: Baptism is a Sacrament of faith, and the Church asks for a serious and loving commitment by the parents and godparents of a child to live the life of the Sacraments. Parents wishing to baptise their child at English Martyrs Church Streatham should be living in the parish for more than 6 months. If you belong to another parish you will need to obtain a letter of permission from your parish priest. If you are new to the Parish, you can get a letter from your previous parish to say that you are a practising Catholic. Baptisms to take place on the last Sunday of every month at 2pm. The date will be confirmed once the preparation course is completed. Please collect a Baptism pack from the parish office for registration at least four weeks before the preparation date.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2026: First Holy Communion registration for 2026 is closed now. Parents who have registered please note the First lesson for children and parents is on Saturday 10th January 2026 at 9.30am.

CONFIRMATION 2026: Registration for 2026 is closed. First meeting for Candidate and parents is on Friday 16th January 2026 at 7pm in the Church.
