BAPTISM AT ENGLISH MARTYRS CHURCH: Baptism is a Sacrament of faith, and the Church asks for a serious and loving commitment by the parents and godparents of a child to live the life of the Sacraments. Parents wishing to baptise their child at English Martyrs Church Streatham should be living in the parish for more than 6 months. If you belong to another parish you will need to obtain a letter of permission from your parish priest. If you are new to the Parish, you can get a letter from your previous parish to say that you are a practising Catholic. Baptisms to take place on the last Sunday of every month at 2pm. The date will be confirmed once the preparation course is completed. Please collect a Baptism pack from the parish office for registration at least four weeks before the preparation date.

ENGLISH MARTYR FOR THE WEEK is Robert Salt. Robert Salt was one of the many Carthusian monks at the Charterhouse monastery in London who were persecuted for their Catholic faith. He refused to swear the Oath of Supremacy, which would have required him to deny his Catholic faith and the authority of the Pope and instead to acknowledge Henry V111 as the supreme church leader. His refusal led him to be imprisoned at Newgate Jail where he was starved to death. His courage in circumstances where he knew death was the consequence is an inspiration in times where we may face challenge or strife, to remember that our faith in God will provide us with strength to face adversity.

(This means attending Saturday Vigil or Sunday Masses) If children are planning to register for Sacraments in the future at English Martyrs Church please do get a Mass Attendance Card and get it stamped.
