ENGLISH MARTYR THIS WEEK: JOHN ROBINSON - It is no coincidence that very many of the martyrs we commemorate in our church were priests in seminaries, who as well as practising their own faith, did all they could to ensure that young men could study to become the priests of the future. John turned to the priesthood following the death of his wife. He studied in Belgium and came back to England knowing he was risking his life. He was arrested and held in prison for 2 years before being hung for the crime of being a priest. We should honour the memory of John Robinson and the many priests put to death by remembering to pray for vocations and to support those who are called to the priesthood.
