WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR MIGRANTS & REFUGEES

On Sunday 27 September, the Church marks the 112th World Day of Migrants and Refugees. This year's theme, 'Even just one of these children', comes from Pope Leo XIV's message and invites us to reflect on the dignity, needs, and hopes of migrant and refugee children and young people. For many children, home is not a place of safety. Conflict, persecution, poverty, and climate change can force families to leave behind everything they know. As Christians, we are reminded that Jesus himself knew what it meant to be a refugee. In the Gospel of Matthew, Joseph is warned to take Mary and the child Jesus and flee to Egypt because Herod seeks the child's life. As we mark Refugee Sunday, may our parishes continue to grow as communities of welcome and belonging, where every person is treated with dignity and every child is given the opportunity to live in safety, surrounded by love and hope.
